## Your Accommodation

Your accommodation is one of the most important elements of your holiday. This is why we have carefully chosen the best hotels and are proud to offer you accommodation boasting levels of comfort, service and cuisine complementing the grade of tour you have chosen. If you would rather have ground floor or neighbouring accommodation, or a room near to the main hotel facilities and have not already advised us, please contact us as early as possible prior to commencing your tour so we can try to accommodate your request (special room requests subject to availability).

## Facilities in Your Room

### Beds

Twin-bedded accommodation usually represents two single beds, though some hotels present twin share accommodation as of one double bed and one single bed.

A double room comprises one double bed designed for two people to share.

Triple rooms generally comprise of one double bed and one single bed or a rollaway bed. Three beds in one room are not common in New Zealand.

### En Suite

All accommodation featured on your tour will have private facilities. Your bathroom will always have a shower, toilet, hand-basin, towels and soap. Generally your bathroom will include a bath. Bidets are not common in New Zealand bathrooms. Most Hotels also provide hairdryers in the room.

### Complimentary Tea/Coffee Making Facilities

We have ensured that the accommodation utilised on your tour provides complimentary tea and coffee making facilities in your room. It should be noted that in a few areas these facilities may not be available.

### Mini Bars/Refrigerators

Most hotels used feature a small refrigerator in the room, and on many occasions, rooms feature a mini bar. This facility operates on an honesty system whereby you pay the hotel prior to departure for any drinks or snacks consumed.

### Television/Radio

Most rooms in which you will stay on tour will have a television and radio, however in a few areas these may not be available.

## Country Homestay

If you have chosen this option in Rotorua, your main luggage will be put into secure storage at the tour hotel. You will need to pack your hand luggage with your overnight requirements.

If for any reason you do not wish to participate in the Country Homestay, please advise immediately, as a 48 hour cancellation penalty does apply and your hotel will need to be re-booked.

## Restaurants

Whilst on tour, all hotels in which you stay have fully licensed bars and restaurants from which you can purchase beverages to enjoy with your meal.

## Meals

We pay careful attention to our menus to ensure choice and a healthy variety of quality food which caters for all tastes. Meals that are included in your tour price are clearly indicated on your itinerary.

Meal plans commence the day after your arrival at the city in which your tour commences. Dinners are not included on the day that you arrive into New Zealand due to flight arrival time variations.

**Breakfasts** are generally buffet-style comprising cereals, fruit juices and cooked dishes (eggs, bacon, sausages, etc.), toast, jams, tea and coffee.

**Lunch** requirements vary greatly. With two meals already included, many people prefer a lighter midday meal or just a snack. As a result, scheduled lunch stops are made allowing you to purchase whatever best suits you.

**Dinners** are at least 3-course meals with multi-choice entrees and main courses, accompanied by salad or vegetables, and dessert. Occasionally dinners are a-la-carte and several are buffet-style offering a wide selection of quality food. Meals are always accompanied by tea and coffee.

Our **Freedom of Choice Dining™** concept, available on specified tours gives you flexibility over your dining arrangements. You choose whether you want to dine early or late, with friends or alone and whether you want a hearty meal or something more simple. It's always up to you and we will arrange it.
